REGULATION ON THE MOVEMENT OF PLAYERS

BETWEEN CLUBS IN CUMBRIA

1. The transfer of players between clubs in Cumbria must follow the regulations laid down in RFU Regulation 14, and:
2. This Cumbria RFU regulation applies to the process to be adopted where:
 - A player registered to a Cumbrian club wishes to move to another Cumbrian club
 - When a Cumbrian club wishes to obtain the services of a player registered to another Cumbrian club
 - Any individual of a Cumbrian club making an approach making an approach to another Cumbrian club to obtain the services of one of its registered players will be deemed to be acting on behalf of his club. (This includes the coach and officials of the county XVs)
3. When a Cumbrian club receives an approach from a player registered with another club, officials of that club must advise officials of the player's club of the approach, irrespective of whether or not they consider the player would be an asset to

their player base. If they wish to proceed with the move, then they must not take action in accordance with RFU Regulation 14, until the losing club has been informed.

4. When a Cumbrian club considers that a player from another club would be an asset to their player base, then before making any approach to that player they must inform that club of their intentions. Such action begins the negotiations.
5. Any action by a club that is contrary to this regulation will be dealt with under RFU Rule 5.12 (Conduct Prejudicial to the Interests of the Game) for which the sanction is open ended.
